**Guided Conservatory Tour** | \$6 per person during general admission - \$8 during show

Enhance your Conservatory visit with a guided tour! Tour will feature information on interesting and blooming plants, as well as historical information. Available year-round at Conservatory.

**Herbal Teas** | \$7 per person during general admission - \$9 during show

Discover the history of herbal teas and the uses of specific herbs in teas. After the presentation, we will head out to the children's garden to make a cup of herbal tea and sachet to take home from our herbs. Available May-October.



**All About Chocolate** | \$8 per person during general admission - \$10 during show

Travel through the history of chocolate from the Olmecs to present day chocolate manufacturing. Learn how chocolate has evolved over the centuries and how it is made today. Then take a brief tour of the Conservatory to see our chocolate tree and if there are ripe pods, cut one open and see inside. Available year-round.



**Coffee and Conservation** | \$9 per person during general admission - \$11 during show

Join us as we discover the history of coffee and gain a greater appreciation for one of our favorite beverages. Learn more about how coffee can be grown in harmony with the rainforest and protect Indiana native migratory birds. Then take a brief tour of the Conservatory to see our Coffee tree and if there are ripe fruits, see where the beans come from.

**Pollinator & Wildlife Gardening** | \$6 per person during general admission - \$8 during show

While Garfield is home to a tropical conservatory, we support local wildlife through our outdoor gardening projects. Learn about plants that provide food and shelter for local wildlife through a presentation and then a tour of the pollinator and wildlife garden in Blake's Children's Garden. Available May-Sept.



**Garfield Park History** | \$6 per person during general admission - \$7 during show

Garfield Park is the oldest park in the Indianapolis Parks System. Learn about this historical and architectural gem in the city. Discover the many events and activities that have happened over the years in the park. Available year-round and or off-site.
